## 9. Open Forum

Kiss and Ride Concerns and Etiquette - People are stopping in the Kiss and Ride line and leaving their vehicle causing frustration with other parents. There are also safety concerns with children crossing through the parking lot when parents stop in front of the parked cars in the lot. Jennifer will send a notice about Kiss and Ride on Monday.

Students from the portables are eating on the gym floor - Jennifer indicated that last year there were more fights in the portables because there are not enough volunteers to watch each portable. She also said there is no storage for tables and that most kids are either standing or on the tarps for a few minutes as they generally eat their lunch quickly. Tarps are currently being used for the kids to sit on if they decide to sit down in the gym. Parents are still not comfortable with that arrangement.

Air Conditioning Concerns – this is a concern with parents and staff but the issue goes past the school and the DCDSB. This is something that needs to be mandated by the Ministry of Education.
