

Early Dismissals/Change of Pick Up Routine



We ask for your support in limiting the disruptions to the day and routines of your child as much as possible. We realize emergencies arise or appointments where you have no choice of time but if as much as possible, we can have the children dismissed at the regular time. Also, if student's end of day routines can remain consistent. We frequently get calls into the Office just before the bell, asking for changes to the students dismissal routine. Some classes have gym at the end of the day or go outside and the message is unable to get to them in time and they take the bus when they were supposed to be picked up. If students and their teachers can be made aware of these changes one day in advance, we can ensure there is no confusion.
